

Immersion Language Programs in SFUSD 2010-2011

Dual Language Immersion Programs—Designed for 1) native or bilingual speakers of Cantonese, Korean, Mandarin, or Spanish; and 2) native English speakers. Students in the Two-Way Immersion program are educated in both English and the target language. The goal is for students to read, write, speak, and understand in both languages. Enrollment in Dual Immersion programs is balanced between ½ to 2/3 native/bilingual speakers and ½ to 1/3 English-only students.
